



SEAL IJ warranty systems

introduction

Starting from February 2005, SEAL offers several warranty systems for a combination of InkJet media and pressure sensitive Laminates.

Two warranties have been chosen to be the ones to start with; these are:

a) SEAL IJ solvent economy vinyl system

features: This warranty offers the customer a **1 year guarantee** for the following material compounds:

- **SEAL IJ solvent economy vinyl gloss 80 PA + SEAL PrintShield (Standard) gloss / matte / lustre**
- **SEAL IJ solvent economy vinyl gloss 80 GPA + SEAL PrintShield (Standard) gloss / matte / lustre**
- **SEAL IJ solvent economy vinyl matt 80 PA + SEAL PrintShield (Standard) gloss / matte / lustre**

The applications this system is designed for and is restricted to are short- to mid-term outdoor applications on even and slightly curved surfaces.

b) SEAL IJ solvent premier vinyl system

features: This warranty offers the customer a **5 year guarantee** for the following material compounds:

- **SEAL IJ solvent premier vinyl 60 PA + SEAL IJ solvent clear vinyl 60**
- **SEAL IJ solvent premier vinyl 80 PA + SEAL IJ solvent clear vinyl 80**

The applications this system is designed for and restricted to are mid- to long-term outdoor applications on even and curved surfaces; also usable on vehicles if not applied over sharp creases or protruding rivets.

Every warranty includes the necessity for the customer to properly treat the printing and finishing and to obey sufficient dry time after printing. Also, batch codes and product codes of the materials used are to be filed for reference, along with a sample of the actual material compound that has to be sent in with the warranty claim form that is part of every warranty certificate.

In a case of claimed warranty, the customer needs to send the warranty claim form to the distributor, to inform him of the claim. The distributor then sends the claim on to SEAL for evaluation and processing

All warranties state that only the defective material will be replaced; SEAL can not be made liable for further costs like inks, time spent and so forth.
